



Rental agreement for the student body's car

Rent

The student body's car is rented at a set cost of 80 SEK per day and 4 SEK per kilometre. Invoice is sent by email when the mileage according to the meter indication is reported by the one responsible. Payment must be made to the student body, "I-sektionen", not later than 30 days after the invoice has been received. In case of late payment the renter is obliged to pay fees for the payment reminder and additional interest due to the delayed payment, according to Swedish law.

Responsibilities

The car keys are collected and signed for at the car responsible or person designated by the former. The renter is responsible for contacting the car responsible at least 48 hours before the rental starts and agreeing upon a time and place for the hand-over of the car keys. If the car isn't used during the time of rental, the minimum fee of 80 SEK per day is charged.

The renter is responsible for the car being returned to the parking outside the Vasa building. This is the case even if the car needs to be towed. Any tickets or fees incurred during the time of rental, such as parking and speeding tickets, shall be paid by the renter.

The renter shall control the car both before and after rental using the inspection protocol ("besiktningsprotokoll"). Known damage and defects are marked on the information paper. If new or unmarked damage is found this shall be immediately reported to the car responsible. If the renter does not report a previously unmarked defect or damage before use, and the next renter reports it before start of usage, the previous renter will automatically be considered responsible for the damage and for payment of any costs related to it. The protocol also concerns cleaning of the car.

The car **must be refuelled with diesel**, not ordinary gasoline. When refuelling, save the receipt and give it to the car responsible. The amount will be deducted from the cost of rental. If the car for any reason is filled up with the wrong fuel it shall not be started and the car responsible must be contacted. The renter is responsible for any damage due to wrong fuel being used, and for payment thereof.

All use of the car is at your own risk.

The car may not be used outside of Sweden.

Deposit

A deposit of 300 SEK is collected when the car keys are handed out. Associations and committees of the student board may choose to have their deposit standing for a longer period of time.



Obligations

The renter is responsible for entering the mileage according to the meter indication in the journal placed in the car, both before and after usage. If the renter should discover that the numbers in the journal are not correct before use, it is the renter's responsibility to report it to the car responsible. Otherwise the renter may be charged with the full cost.

The car shall be cleaned and returned in the same condition it was in when the rental started. All seats need to be mounted and in place. The diesel tank shall be at least a quarter full. If any of these conditions are not fulfilled, the deposit will not be repaid.

The car keys shall be returned on specified time or at time agreed upon with the car responsible. If the car keys have been lost, the renter is obliged to pay fees and costs related to the loss.

Breaking any of the rental rules may lead to suspension from using the car.

In case of accident

During tasks related to promoting and forwarding the student body:

- The renter pays for costs up to 500 SEK.

As a member of the student body:

- The renter pays for costs up to 3000 SEK.

Others

- The renter pays for the total costs in case of accident. Regarding larger damages, where insurance companies need to be contacted and involved, the renter pays the full deductible.
