1. Purpose
2. Membership

- i. Acquisition

- All members of the Student Union registered at the student body of Industrial Engineering and Management (Teknologsektionen Industriell Ekonomi) are members of the student body.

- ii. Rights

- All members of the student body have rights of attendance, speech, proposal and voting at the general assembly.
- Only members of the student body are eligible for elected offices within the student body, with the exception of the posts of inspector and auditor.
- Members have the right to take part of meeting minutes and the student body's other non-confidential documentation. Confidentiality is decided upon by the student body's authorized signatory.
- Members have the right to use the services of the student body and participate in its events and activities.

- iii. Obligations

- Members are obliged to follow the policies, regulatory documents and other decisions of the student body within its operations.

3. Finances and authorized signatory

- i. The chairman and treasurer of the board of the student body are in unison the authorized signatory of the student body. The board reserves the right to, in exceptional cases, appoint a certain authorized signatory.

4. Identity of the student body

- i. The English name of the student body is The Student Body of Industrial engineering and Management.
- ii. James Bond is the patron saint of the student body.
- iii. The student body's colour is purple and its ribbon has the colours purple – white – purple.
- iv. The song of the student body is "Staten och Kapitalet".



5. Organisation and responsibilities

i. Organs

The operations of the student body consists of:

- The general assembly
- The Nominations Committee
- The Board of the Student Body
- Committee
- Possible other organs

ii. Regulatory documents

The operations of the student body are regulated by the following documents, in descending order:

- Statute
- Regulations
- Policies, instructions and orders of operations

Decisions regarding changes in these statutes require a three quarters majority at two subsequent general assemblies with at least 15 days in between them. Additionally, The Board of the Chalmers Student Union also needs to approve the changes. The second time this is dealt with the current suggestion of statute changes can only be upheld or dismissed, not changed.

Revision of the regulations requires a three quarters majority at a general assembly.

Decisions regarding annulment, adoption or changes to a policy or instruction are made by the board. Policies concern the entire student body, while instructions concern individual organs.

Decisions regarding changes in an order of operations is made by the concerned organ itself.

Any conflict of interpretation regarding these regulatory documents is to be decided by the inspector.

iii. Fiscal year

- The fiscal year of the student body is according to calendar year.

6. General assembly

- i. The general assembly is the highest deciding organ of the student body.
- ii. The general assembly consists of physically present members of the student body.
- iii. The general assembly convenes when summoned by the board. Summons are to be announced at least seven (7) school days before the meeting.
- iv. The general assembly shall convene at least four times during the fiscal year, with at least one meeting each study period.
- v. The following are entitled to demand an extra general assembly:
 - Member of the Board of the Student Body
 - Inspector of the Student Union or the Student Body
 - The Board of the Chalmers Student Union
 - The auditors of the Student Body
 - At least 25 members

In such cases an extra general assembly shall be held within fifteen (15) school days.

- vi. A general assembly has a quorum if at least 25 members are present
- vii. The chairman of the general assembly has the deciding vote concerning decisions of simple majority or equal number of votes, if nothing else is specified in this statute.
- viii. Concerning election of individual the following stands:
 - More than half of the submitted and approved votes are required for an individual to be elected. If none of the candidates receives this a re-election is to be held between the two candidates with the highest number of votes. If both candidates receive equal number of votes in the second election, drawing of lots is to decide.
 - If more than one individual is to be elected, candidates with the highest number of votes are elected. With equal number of votes the drawing of lots is to decide.
- ix. Decisions made by the general assembly, in violation with the statutes of the Student Union or the Student Body, may be annulled by the Student Union Council.

- x. Minutes are to be taken during general assemblies and published in adjusted state no later than ten (10) days after the meeting. The minutes are adjusted by the chairman, the secretary and the two elected verifiers of the general assembly.

7. Inspector

- i. The general assembly elects an inspector among the employees of the university to support and examine the operations of the student body.
- ii. The inspector is entitled to full disclosure of the operations of the student body and its administration.

8. Auditing

- i. The general assembly elects at least two (2) auditors to examine the operations and administration of the student body. They may not hold any other elected office within the student body.
- ii. The auditors shall submit their audit of the previous fiscal year's operations as well as previously non-discharged operations. This shall contain statements regarding the discharge of involved parties.

9. Nomination Committee

- i. The Nomination Committee shall consist of a chairman and at least three other members.

10. The Board of the Student Body

- i. The Board of the Student body shall lead the operations of the student body.
- ii. The Board consists of a chairman, vice chairman, treasurer as well as other members.
- iii. The chairman is to, on request from a member of the Board or inspector, call to a board meeting.
- iv. *The Board of the Student Body* is obliged:
 - to prepare matters for the general assembly
 - to be responsible for the operations and finances of the student body



to execute decisions made by the general assembly

to oversee the interests of the members

11. Committees

- i. Committees shall perform operations that are beneficial to the members of the student body

12. Dissolution

- i. The rules for dissolution are the same as for changing the statute.
- ii. Should the number of members of the student body be 25 or less the Board of the Student Union has the right to seize the rights and obligations of the general assembly.
- iii. If the student body is dissolved its assets fall to the Chalmers Student Union.
